I'm really excited that you and Richard will be coming to the next PAMA meeting! I'm eager to get everyone in PA on board with the BID, and it will be a wonderful opportunity for the merchants to hear the history and ask questions. Thank you!

We have had a lot of good feedback from folks re the festival. (And at the PAMA meeting we'll be able to hear more from those who haven't commented yet.) Here are some of the things they have said:

- Bird Cafe & Supper Club (Nicole Ponsler): "I want to extend our heartfelt appreciation for all those
 involved in making the 1st annual almost fringe festival such a major success! We at Bird Cafe got to
 pay some bills after this super busy weekend! Hope you all had fun!"
- Wharf Master's Inn (Deborah Housen): "Wharf Master's Inn was booked solid for three nights. Whooo
 Hoooo! I felt there should've been an Information Booth. Maps to some of the places, etc., would've
 been nice. I spent a good part of my time printing maps and directions for guests and calling
 businesses with questions."
- Unbeaten Path Tours (Margaret Lindgren): "...Unbeaten Path was booked solid and our tours were all over, not just in the PA Stornetta Lands."
- Roots Herbal Apothecary (Gillian Nye): "...Roots reported great sales and lots of happy customers.
 Sounds like many people knew there were discounts and fun to be found & were out for the party!
 Thanks to everyone who made it happen ~ looking forward to next year!"
- Outback Garden & Feed (Rebecca Golly): "...we had many tourists come thru Outback."
- Zen House (Kelley Litle): "Did sales increase as a result...YES!! 2) Was event well attended...for our shop YES, over 70+ folds through our shop w/40ish folks attending our panel discussion. 3) Did new potential clients attend vs. our regulars...again YES...over 75% of our attendees were unfamiliar to us. 4) Did folds enjoy themselves, were they engaged...Again, for our shop...YES! Also...5) I think it's important to draw both locals and visitors...we had both locals new to our shop and visitors from S.F., Sacramento, Santa Rosa...even clients from San Luis Obispo came specifically for our event and the festival...Also heard Skinluv had a very successful day, Zepparella sold out, as did the Brew Master's Dinner! GREAT FIRST TIME EVENT!"

A couple areas to improve upon: Maps/info (as in the above comment) and FOOD! We need food booths next time—perhaps at the park with the music, and/or mixed in with the pop-up gallery. (215 doesn't open until 3pm, and Uneda Eat even later, so there were very few food options. We can probably convince these merchants to open earlier for the festival next year.)
